

RE-OPENING ESSC: CORONAVIRUS COVID-19 OPERATIONS RISK ASSESSMENTS



A phased re-opening place for return to sailing - only when appropriate, safe, and following government guidance.

Overview:

- Level 5 - The government allows non-essential staff back to work but there is no sporting activity in the UK, no other sailing clubs open.
- Level 4 - Community sports clubs re-start activities, ESSC re-opens with a minimum viable product for members to go free sailing in limited sailing conditions.
- Level 3 - Re-starting other services for members, like racing in limited sailing conditions.
- Level 2 - Racing in expanded conditions, training where possible, limited open meetings.
- Level 1 - Return to standard operating procedures, with full open events, training and socials.
